BLS Regulations Report	M. Bailey- Public hearing was held on December 19 th . The Secretary of Health stopped the regulations from moving forward. Emergency regs will not be implemented. BLS regs will begin the process all over again in the various committees of the EMS Council.

New Business National EMS Memorial Service	Rocky Johnson reported. Seven people were inducted last year and eight will be inducted this year. Medicare Update	S. Hockenbury-National ambulance fee schedule will be implemented by HCFA effective January 1, 2001. Several pages of information was reviewed. The proposed schedule is rather complex and as proposed would create new base rate classifications as well as new rates. Medicare providers billing on both Part A and Part B will be affected. The fee schedule will be implemented in four phases over a four year period. The finale rule is expected to be published in the federal register in October. KAPA needs to have an early summer meeting concerning rates and making plans/adjustments for the new fee schedule.
