Discussed Medicare and medication shortages. Discussed VA reimbursement. KAPA has continued to follow up on issues discussed.</li> <li>Two prefiled bills for Kentucky Legislature. One (BR100) relates to Naloxone that would permit administration by first responders in apparent opiate overdose situations. BR140 would create for professional firefighters the inclusion of cancer caused by work environment as a hazardous duty benefit.</li> <li>Joe Prewitt discussed a bill that is planned to be filed that would require high school students to be trained (but not certified) in CPR before they graduate high school. Mr. Prewitt motioned that KAPA support this bill with a letter of support. Second. Discussion on required curriculum; clarified that KAPA would be supporting a concept. Motion passed.</li> </ul>
